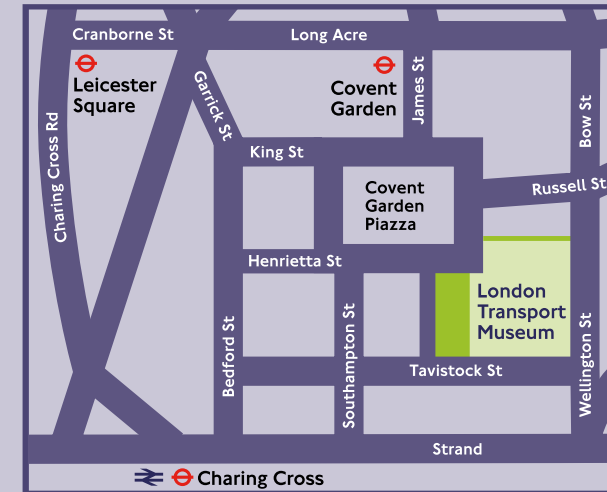
- ♦ Free access to the Museum during all normal opening hours. Concessionary entry to the Museum Depot at Acton Town on open days

The Direct Debit Guarantee

- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that take part in the Direct Debit scheme. The efficiency and security of the scheme is monitored and protected by your own bank or building society.
- If the amount paid or the payment dates change, London Transport Museum Friends will notify you 14 working days in advance of your account being debited, or as otherwise agreed.
- If an error is made by London Transport Museum Friends or your bank or building society, you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your bank or building society. Please also send a copy of your letter to us.

Gift Aid

Your subscription and other payments to the Friends can all be treated as Gift Aid. This means that we reclaim tax you have already paid. We can increase our income by 28% at absolutely no extra cost or trouble to you. The only condition is that you must have paid Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the amount we reclaim. If you pay tax at a higher rate, you can yourself claim tax relief. Gift Aid declarations may be cancelled at any time. You should advise us if you no longer pay tax sufficient to cover our claim.
