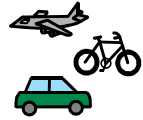

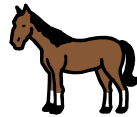


London's first omnibus

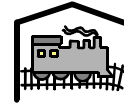
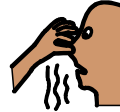


## First underground

People couldn't see where to get off.

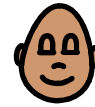


# Shelter underground
