

# Springtime Excursion FAQ

## What will the event be like?

Upon arrival, a light breakfast will be available and you'll be invited to listen to a talk on the restoration of the X-type. Afterwards, you'll be shown to the bus to begin the narrated tour along the original X2 route.

At Hampstead Heath, we'll stop off for a three-course lunch at the historic **Holly Bush pub**, before the journey continues. Once back at the Museum, you are welcome to stay on and visit the X-type and explore our world class collection.

The route follows: Covent Garden – Russell SQ – Euston – Chalk Farm – Hampstead Heath – Waterloo Bridge – Walworth – Camberwell Green – Covent Garden.

## General information

**Guest age** – this event is only suitable for guests who are 18 and over.

**Registration** – upon arrival at the Museum ensure you register in the Cubic foyer. You'll receive a colour-coded wristband for your journey. Please put the wristband on straight away, as duplicates cannot be issued.

**Access** – due to the nature of older vehicles there is no step free access or place to safely accommodate wheelchairs on the bus. We can store wheelchairs at the Museum during the tour.

**Bathroom facilities** – bathroom facilities are available at the Museum before and after the tour, and during lunch at the Holly Bush.

**Boarding** – Museum staff will be available to help you board the bus after breakfast and the talk is over.

**Late arrivals** – if anyone in your party arrives after the talk ends and misses the tour start, refunds will not be given.

**Dogs** – dogs are not permitted, please contact us if you have a guide dog so we can accommodate.

**Food and drink/ lunch options** – whilst food and drink can be taken on the bus, we ask that you keep your area tidy. For breakfast, there is a choice of drinks and pastries. You'll be contacted before the tour and given a set menu to choose your lunch options from. Lunch includes a glass of fresh lemonade; other drinks are available to be purchased separately. Food allergies can be catered for.

**Photography** – we encourage photography at the event, however tripods are not permitted.

**Tour end time** – the length of the tour may vary depending on travel time.
