Cutting Edge: Dulwich Picture Gallery

6 September, 09.15

Join us for an early morning private view and guided tour of 'Cutting Edge: Modernist British Printmaking' featuring 120 prints, drawings and posters from the 1930s at the Sir John Soane designed Dulwich Picture Gallery. Discover the pioneering printmakers who captured the spirit of 1930s Britain in this major show of the Grosvenor School of Modern Art which also features works from the London Transport Museum collection. After the tour we will go for coffee and pastries in the Gallery café.



Piccadilly Circus tour

16 September, 12:00 – 13:15 & 14:00 – 15:15

This is your chance to explore the secret doors, passageways and lift shafts that have been closed to the public at Piccadilly Circus since 1929. Discover original Edwardian design features, fascinating stories of wartime sheltering and the role of the station in the top-secret storage of priceless artefacts. Guided by Siddy Holloway, Patrons will also be able to access a disused passage that does not form part of the public tour.
