

Aldwych Underground station open days



Terms and conditions

Please read the following carefully –
Essential information for all ticket holders.

Aldwych is a non-operational London Underground station. The entrance is located on the Strand at the junction with Surrey Street WC2R 2NE

Access to the platform is by staircase only and there is no working lift in operation. 160 stairs connect the ticket hall level to the platform level – there is no step-free access. It is advisable therefore that you should have a moderate to high level of fitness for your health and safety as you will be required to walk out in case of an emergency. If you appear not to meet this requirement you may be refused entry.

You must arrive at Aldwych 15 minutes before the visit you are booked on takes place. If you do not arrive on time, your place may be sold to another visitor, due to very high demand for this event.

Aldwych Underground station open days is an event best accessed via public transport. There is no on-site parking available. For the easiest way to get to the event visit www.tfl.gov.uk/journeyplanner or call 0843 222 1234

This ticket is issued by London Transport Museum. Entry to Aldwych tube station is by ticket only. Entry shall constitute an acceptance of the following terms and conditions:

Every member of the audience must possess a valid ticket that must be produced to gain entry into the station and on to the event. No pass outs or re-admissions are permitted.

Lost tickets will not be replaced. Please keep your ticket safe.

We will refuse entry to guests wearing open toe sandals or high-heeled shoes. Feet must be fully covered, sturdy walking shoes are recommended.

Due to the limited space for bags and coats, no large or heavy bags are to be brought to the event. A cloakroom for smaller items is available.

No food or drink is to be consumed inside the station. Smoking is prohibited on the premises.

No professional audio visual or audio recording equipment may be brought into the venue without the express permission of London Transport Museum. No digital SLR cameras will be allowed into the station.

All ticket holders consent to the photography of themselves as members of the audience.

This event is not suitable for children under 16 years of age. All visitors must bring valid proof of age (passport, photo driver's licence or PASS card). No dogs will be allowed into the station.

You will be refused entry to the station if you appear to be under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances.

Booking dates and event times are non-transferable. Tickets will not be refunded if it is within 7 days of your event date.

If the ticket is sold or transferred for commercial gain via an intermediary it becomes void and the holder will be refused entry to the event.

Admission to the event is at the ticket holders own risk, and the management shall have no liability whatsoever for any loss, damage or injury to person or property, except that the Management does not seek to exclude liability for death or personal injury caused by their negligence.

The management reserves the right to refuse entry to the event site at its absolute discretion.

The management reserves the right to make any changes to the programme owing to unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances, including cancellation of the event.
