Frequently asked questions

Is parking available at the Depot?

There is no parking available at the Depot, except for disabled badge holders.

I have mobility issues/am a wheelchair user, will I be able to go on a tour?

The Museum Depot is fully accessible to wheelchair users. Cab It! is unfortunately not suitable for wheelchair users, as due to the nature of the collection the vehicles are not accessible for wheelchairs.

What age group are the tours suitable for?

Our tours have a factual nature and are aimed at an adult audience. If guests aged 16 and under have a keen interest in transport the tours would still be suitable, however please note that they must be accompanied by an adult. We occasionally offer tours specifically aimed at families, for further information please contact our Booking Team – details below.

Is photography allowed?

Photography is allowed for private purposes in the main shed only, however tripods are not allowed. For conservation purposes we do not allow photography in any of the small stores.

Are toilet facilities available?

Yes, toilet and baby changing facilities are available.

Is there a cloakroom?

No, but there are free lockers available to use.

Is there a café on site?

No, but there are cafés located nearby.
